FOPC sponsored an Invasive Plant Symposium March 29, 2025 featuring 3 speakers. What a wealth of information was shared that day! And as importantly was the networking between groups and individuals in our area.

FOPC has been awarded two grants to plant native plants in the parking lot islands near the Nature Center. We will begin the preparation and planting of this area soon. Our Summer Concert Series has been very popular over the last few years. We began our series some years ago with grants from Indiana Arts Commission. During Covid these grants were discontinued.
